FY 2017-18 Water Pipeline Replacement Project Update

This update provides information on CVWD's pipeline replacement project on the 2700 & 3000-3100 blocks of Brookhill Street, and the 5000 block of La Crescenta Ave. Below you'll find useful information and a construction schedule for this project.

The project will replace old 6-inch water pipelines on the 2700 & 3000-3100 blocks of Brookhill Street, and the 5000 block of La Crescenta Avenue with new 8-inch diameter water pipelines. These water pipelines were originally installed in 1946 and 1956. Since then, the pipelines have developed numerous leaks necessitating the replacement of the 8-inch.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE (As of January 5, 2018):

- Pipe Delivery at 5041 Cloud Ave on 1/15/18 at 8am.
- Start Construction at Pennsylvania/Brookhill St. intersection (City of Glendale) on 1/15/18 at 8am, proceeding east from intersection to Quail Creek Channel only.
- City of Glendale Proposed Paving Project Start, 2/20/18 (City of Glendale to provide more information).
- Construction to resume on 3/12/18, at the 3100, 3000, and 2700 blks. of Brookhill St.

Access will be provided for emergencies, mail delivery, and trash services. Residents will have access to their properties at all times. CVWD advises that residents avoid traveling through the construction zone whenever possible. CVWD will provide an updated construction schedule via CVWD's website (www.cvwd.com) to better inform the residents of the construction activities as the project progresses.

As in most construction projects, this work will create a certain amount of unavoidable public inconvenience.

Two issues that the public needs to know about during construction:

1. There will be a period of time, usually between 6 to 8 hours, when the water service to your home will be shut down. This will occur when the contractor ties the new water pipeline into the existing water pipeline. The District will send another letter regarding the contractor's construction schedule and the anticipated shutdown date. In addition, CVWD will notify each resident, a minimum of 48 hours before the actual shutdown, with a door hanger that indicates the date and time of the shutdown.
2. The contractor will be installing temporary parking and traffic restrictions along La Crescenta Ave. Brookhill Street, Pennsylvania Avenue, and Cloud Avenue. This will allow the contractor's crew to work in a safe and expeditious manner to complete the project. "Temporary No Parking" signs will be posted a minimum of two (2) days before construction. The District asks that you observe these signs and any other traffic control. Driveways within the construction zone may be temporarily restricted due to the construction. CVWD's on-site inspector and the contractor will assist you with access into and out of your driveway.
